Dear Senator Boxer and Congresswoman Capps:

Thank you for your September 1, 2015 letter to FCA US LLC (FCA US) regarding the company's position on the Raechel and Jacqueline Houck Rental Car Safety Act (S. 1173) (H.R. 2198). We appreciate your continued interest in this issue and providing us with the opportunity to share our views.

FCA US believes that all customers, including rental car companies, should be able to have their recalled vehicles repaired in a timely manner and that all customers should be treated equally whether they are driving their own vehicles or ones they rented. For this reason, FCA US continues to support the Alliance of Automobile Manufacturers' legislative proposal regarding rental vehicles subject to recalls. This proposal would prevent rental car companies from renting vehicles unless the prospective renters are notified of the recall and provide written acknowledgement of such notification, or the vehicle is subject to a do-not-drive advisory. This would hold rental car companies to the same standards as auto manufacturers and ensure rental car customers have the same access to vehicle recall and safety information as customers who own an affected vehicle.

Thank you again for your letter and for your ongoing interest in motor vehicle safety.
