I've received a great deal of mail from San Diego in support of a "lemon" law, which leads me to believe that a particular company down there is causing problems. If you are aware of abuses perpetrated by a particular dealer against a number of people, then action against that dealer by the Attorney General may be appropriate. I hope you'll get in touch with Herschel Elkins, the Deputy Attorney General in charge of such matters, at (213) 736-2097. He may be able to give you some advice.

I think a "lemon" law is a good idea, so I've instructed my staff to work on a draft through our interim period. No such bill is currently under consideration.
